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- 10:40AM–12:10PM** **LIFE AS A TAR HEEL TRANSFER** | Hamilton 100, FPG Student Union
 While you are familiar with the college environment, you will find that Carolina is both similar and different from your previous institution in a number of ways. Hear from staff and students about achieving success at UNC-Chapel Hill, and connect with other new students to start building your Carolina Network.

- 1:10–1:30PM** **HEALTHY HEELS** | Hamilton 100
 How will you stay healthy and well as a Carolina student? This session will encourage self-reflection on your plan for self-care at UNC and where to go
- 1:30–1:40PM** **HEELS UNITED: OUR CAROLINA COMMUNITY** | Hamilton 100
 This session will address Carolina’s community expectations as provided in the University’s Policy on Prohibited Discrimination, Harassment and Related Misconduct, which includes sexual and gender-based harassment, sexual violence, interpersonal violence, and stalking. The session will focus on Carolina’s definition of consent and the role we all play in cultivating a culture of respect, inclusion, and safety, including prevention skills and opportunities for student leadership in the area of violence prevention. The session will also highlight important information about support resources and reporting options.

 Campus education and awareness is a critical element of promoting campus safety and the implementation of the University’s crisis and emergency response plans. The Office of the Dean of Students and leaders from Risk Management and Campus Safety departments will share valuable information, including overviews of Alert Carolina, safe transportation, methods for reporting concerns, safety tips, and valuable resources for new students.
