Carolina Covenant Scholars - Room 3205

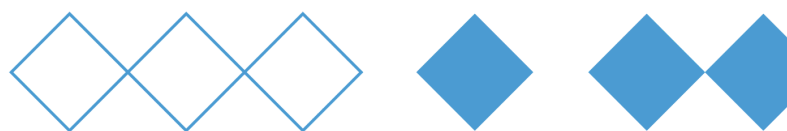

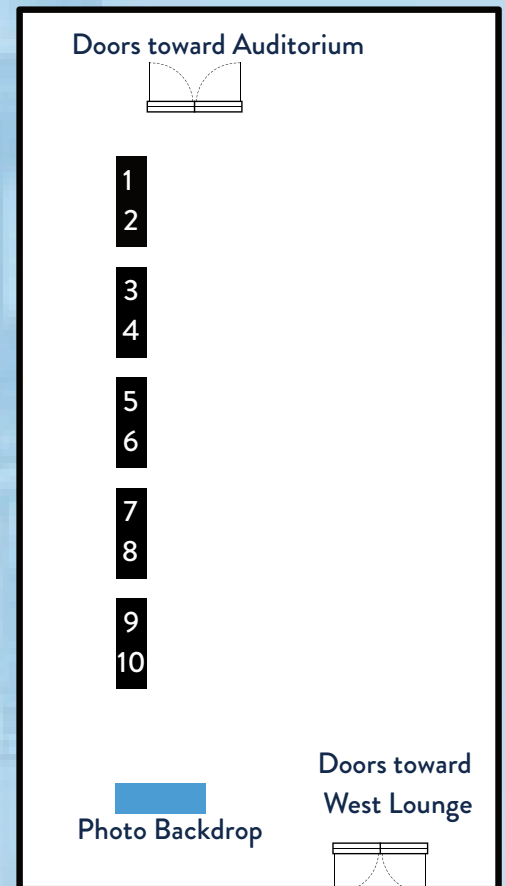
